We also accept proof of handicap from your mobile phone, if your phone has internet access. We **do not accept** the England Golf cards, as we are not affiliated to England Golf, and therefore have no access to the Central Database of Handicaps. In future, therefore, please bring the required alternative proofs of your up to date handicap.
- Inclement weather. Please check on the website of the venue to see if there is a telephone number to ring to find out the status of the course on the day of the event. In addition, the Organiser of the event will have sent you as part of your confirmation an emergency mobile number to **ring on the day**.
