VETERAN LADIES' GOLF ASSOCIATION LANCASHIRE BRANCH

1.—The Association shall be called "The Veteran Ladies' Golf Association, Lancashire Branch" (hereinafter called " The Association.").

Every year of the Association shall begin on 1st annuary, and the term "The Association Year" shall mean any year commencing on 1st January.

Membership.

2.—The following persons are eligible for membership of the Association, viz., Any lady who has attained the age of 50 years and who is a member past or present of any Golf Club which is a Lancashire Club within the meaning of the Rules of the L.G.U., and who is also qualified for membership of the Lancashire Ladies' County Golf Association under the County Golf Regulations of the L.G.U.

Any such lady wishing to become a member of the Association shall be proposed and seconded by two members of the Association, and her name shall be submitted to the Committee hereinafter mentioned. The Committee shall have power, subject to these Rules, to elect members to the Association as they may deem advisable, and may also in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion and without being liable to account for their action in this respect refuse to admit into and may expel from the Association any person whatsoever.

3.—The annual subscription of each member shall be 5/- and the same shall be payable in January.

No member whose subscription is in arrears may Subscriptions.


